Dear Parent(s)/Guardians,

<u>Official School Opening</u>: Our official school opening will take place on December 14th, 2023. In school, we are busy preparing for this special occasion. We wish to involve everyone in this important community event. There will be a whole school Mass for all pupils at 10:30am in Our Lady Queen of Peace Church, Coosan celebrated by Fr. Pat Murphy on the morning of the official opening. Following the Mass, all pupils, with the exception of our 6th classes, our Student Council and Junior Mayors will go home at 12:30pm. The official opening ceremony will take place at 2pm in the GP Room. Bishop Paul Connell will officially open our new school. Following the official opening ceremony, the GP Hall will remain open from 4-5:30pm for anyone who wishes to come in and share in the celebrations. Light refreshments will be served.

Christmas Jumper Day:

This year we will have two non-uniform days during December. The first of these will take place on Friday 15th December in aid of the 'Ronald McDonald House'. Staff and pupils will embrace this initiative.

<u>Uniform:</u>

<u>Please note the following regarding your child's uniform and appearance at school:</u>

- Pupils must come to school in full uniform, clean and tidy.
- No jewellery is allowed except a watch, single pair of small earrings (i.e. ear studs or sleepers, one in each earlobe).
- Facial piercings are not permitted.
- No make-up or fake tan may be worn.
- Pupils with long hair are expected to wear it tied up, in a neat and tidy fashion (not obstructing vision), with no unnatural colours allowed.
- Shorts of an appropriate length and a single colour in keeping with the school uniform are permitted especially when the weather is nice.
