School Self-Evaluation:

Our school's new focus for SSE beginning this year is Wellbeing. School Fees:

- <u>Swimming:</u> Pupils from Coosan NS will attend swimming lessons similar to last year. <u>The charge per pupil will be €50.</u>
- School tours: Fees for school tours this year will be placed on Aladdin in March this year.
- Art & Craft: We would like to thank all who have paid the fee of €50 per pupil and remind any family who has not done so to please do so at your earliest convenience.
- <u>Basketball</u>: We would like to thank all who have paid the fee of €20 per <u>pupil</u> and remind any family who has not done so to please do so at your earliest convenience.
- <u>Voluntary Contribution</u>: In Coosan NS, we are very privileged to have such a wonderful new school building and fantastic grounds. The challenge the school faces both now and into the future will be in maintaining these wonderful facilities as well as running the school in the normal manner each school year. For this reason, the school is asking for a voluntary contribution from each child of €50 capped at €100 per family. <u>This is not compulsory and any contribution will be very much appreciated-thank you!</u>

Uniform:

Please note the following regarding your child's uniform and appearance at school:

- Pupils must come to school in full uniform, clean and tidy.
- No jewellery is allowed except a watch, single pair of small earrings (i.e. ear studs or sleepers, one in each earlobe).
- Facial piercings are not permitted.
- No make-up or fake tan may be worn.
- Pupils with long hair are expected to wear it tied up, in a neat and tidy fashion (not obstructing vision), with no unnatural colours allowed.
- Shorts of an appropriate length and a single colour in keeping with the school uniform are permitted especially when the weather is nice.

Supervision of Pupils:

Please note that the children are supervised from 9.20am-3pm each school day. The school grounds are open to the pupils but we cannot accept responsibility for children arriving before the official opening of the school or remaining on the grounds after school. On wet mornings pupils are admitted and supervised from 9.10am.

Health & Safety:

In the interests of all pupils health and safety we kindly ask everyone to remember:

If pupils are unwell, please do not send them to school, consult your GP, follow public health advice and inform the school so that we can support your child in the case of a long period of absence and when they return to school.

We have children with a variety of allergies attending our school. The school kindly asks that treats are not sent in for the whole class as a birthday celebration and wish to remind everyone that foods with trace elements of nuts are not allowed due to severe nut allergies in our school.

Chewing gum is not permitted in Coosan N.S.. The school would appreciate the support of parents/quardians in ensuring that it does not come into school-Go raibh maith agaibh.

School starts in Coosan N.S. at 9.20 am and it is very important for every child's educational benefit that they are present at this time. Thank you for your support.
