Outside Coaches:

This term we are re-introducing basketball and GAA coaching. All pupils in the school will receive basketball, Gaelic Football and hurling coaching at different intervals throughout the school year. We are also introducing RINKA and Tennis in some classes. These coaching programmes are delivered by experienced, highly skilled coaches and sessions are designed to support and complement the P.E. Curriculum lessons being taught by your child's teacher every week.

"Bus Set Down Only" & "Set Down Only" Areas in Coosan National School:

The "bus set down only" and "set down only" areas in Coosan National School are <u>clearly</u> <u>marked for everyone</u>. Bollards are also in situ for health and safety reasons.

There is <u>no parking permitted</u> at <u>any time</u> in these areas.

The "bus set down only" area is for buses only.


The "set down only" area is for cars and for parents/guardians who wish to drop their child to school.
